
(Dominant hemisphere indicates most active side of brain and body.)

## Hemispheric Dominance





Compare the right eye with the left. The iris with the most color concentration and largest " number of characteristics is the dominant eye. Dominance in the right eye indicates the probability of closer relationship with the father and a tendency for sleeping with the right cheek down. Left eye dominant people prefer to sleep with the left cheek down and usually have a closer relationship with the mother. Left eve dominants are flowing and agreeable. Right eve dominants are structured, organized, and ask more questions. Left eye dominants are attracted to right eye dominants in mate relationships.



## Direction of Flow



Extroversion (A) is indicated by the absence of gold or brown near the pupil, and the appearance of the "ring of expression" (R) away from the pupil. The extrovert is expressively honest, a natural achiever and socially oriented.

Introversion (B) is indicated by a concentrated band of gold or brown immediately encircling the pupil. An introvert has qualities of internalized sensitivity and wisdom to be communicated outwardly. Greater degrees of introversion can lead to darker colors and a seemingly extroverted personality. The ring of expression is not apparent in extremely introverted cases. Introvert and extrovert are attracted to each

Compare the areas of the chart with the eyes to be examined. The existence of a Jewel, Flower or Stream pattern within a numbered region indicates one or more of the attitudes described below. Personal behavior can experience the full range of attitudes within a single day.
